Day 15– Mon, Aug 17

Prayer Focus: Repentance

Scripture: Isaiah 43:1-4

Day 19- Fri, Aug 21

Prayer Focus: Healing (Faith in God) - “Prayer connects us with God, the source of health & wholeness. When we pray for healing, we are not in a begging posture; rather we are coming to God with an attitude of cooperation, gratitude & receptivity in the healing process.” James Wagner

Scripture: Acts 5:12-16

Intercessory Focus: Pray for our prayer ministry team and the Stephen’s Ministry.

Day 20- Sat, Aug 22

Prayer Focus: Surrender– “The greatest glory we can give to GOD is to distrust our own strength utterly, and to commit ourselves wholly to His safe-keeping” Brother Lawrence

Scripture: Romans 6:1-11

Intercessory Focus: Pray for the willingness to trust God and His goodness.
